**I am interested in helping in the following areas:**

**Hot Lunch** - The hot lunch program is offered weekly on Fridays and requires a minimum of 2-3 volunteers most weeks. Volunteers will assist with the cooking, serving and cleanup or lunch pick up in Leduc or Devon. Time commitment is approx 2 hours. May be on a continued rotational basis, or even just a one time helper.

**Lice Check** - Lice Checks take place throughout the year, typically in September, January and April. The time commitment required is approximately 1-2 hours per Lice Check event.
